Class dojo is a learning platform that allows practitioners to document and share the day in Pre School with families via a web browser which will enable you to access the content on any device. Class Dojo has a communication feature, such as a feed for photos and videos from the day and messaging that can be translated into more than 35 languages.

Uniform and clothing

Uniform/clothing

Please ensure that your child is dressed in clothes where they can move freely. Your child will be discovering the world around them and exploring whilst at Pre School. There will be a range of different experiences. Please ensure that your child is in clothing that can be easily washed.

School jumpers and cardigans

They will be at our Stay and Play session on Monday 8th July 2024 so that you can try items on and purchase if you wish.

Welly Boots and waterproofs

Send in wellies and waterproofs named. These will stay in preschool and be sent home at half terms for washing. Every child will have yearly access to garden so they will need these items daily to stay warm and dry. Each child will have their own peg under our patio to hang them. If they get especially wet/ dirty, we will send them home on an individual basis for washing.

Coats

Children must bring a coat every day. These might come home dirty or a little bit wet due to the play experiences we provide.

Shoes

Closed shoes must be worn at all times. Strappy sandals are not suitable. Shoes should have Velcro fastenings (no laces) so children can take their shoes off and put them on independently.

Name clothing:

Please ensure that all clothing, including shoes, lunch boxes, and water bottles are clearly marked with your child's name to encourage their independence.

Book bags

Every child must have a book bag so that your child can bring their learning home from Preschool.

Money matters

Important Nursery Grant Funding:

Early Years declaration forms are completed each term. Children are automatically eligible for 15 hours of funding the term after they are 3 years old.

If you wish to access 30 hours funding (15 hours more than the automatic 15hours) or the new 2 year old 15 hour funding, your application must be done online, the term before you want the funding to start. (Working Parent Entitlement)

https://www.gov.uk/apply-30-hours-free-tax-free-childcare There is criteria to meet. If eligible, you will be given a unique code, which must be re-confirmed online every 3 months from when you first applied. It is the parent's / carers responsibility to make sure your child's funding status is kept up to date. We will need to know your child's unique code so that we can process your funding.

One setting cannot claim a mixture of Stretched and Standard funding for the same child. If a child is receiving standard funding at Elburton Preschool for a maximum of 15 hours per week, the maximum stretched funding you can receive at a nursery is 12 hours stretched.

Any additional hours are charged at £6 per hour (this is subject to change). Contact Jo Oak with any funding questions that you may have.
