UNIT 4 – Fruit

Fruit in French, plurals and starting opinions.

UNIT 3 – Animals

Learning some animals in French with their correct article (le / la) and correct spelling using the phonics we have learnt. Introducing I am in French.

UNIT 2 – Days of the week

Learn the days of the week alongside the key phrase 'it is'.

UNIT 1 – I am learning French

Intro to phonics. France and French speaking countries, asking and saying how I feel and my name, numbers 1-10 and colours.

UNIT 5 – Little Red Riding Hood

Intro to a story in French, intro to parts of the body and following instructions to make something.

UNIT 6 – Ice Cream

Intro to question words, alongside phrase 'I would like' within the theme of ice cream.

UNIT 7 – Presenting myself

Revisiting saying name and how we are, numbers 1-10, second phonics set of sounds. Moving on to numbers 11-20 and asking how old you are, where do you live? Exploring nationalities. Preparing a little presentation about who I am.

UNIT 9 – At my House

Looking at the different types of home and locations. Intro of the room in a house and being able to use the phrase "there is/are" in French, as well as "there isn't/aren't". Being able to produce a written piece about who we are and where we live.

UNIT 8 – Family

Introducing family members and their article (le /la) Listening for which family member we hear, exploring the 'my' word in French and moving up to numbers to 100.



UNIT 10 – Pets

Third set of phonics sounds. Introducing animals that are pets and revising the articles. Using the phrase "I have" and "I don't have" and introducing the use of connectives "and" "but".

UNIT 11 – Weather

Introducing how to talk about the weather in French. Focusing on the way the phrases are put together and what is transferable language. Days of the week and working towards performing a weather report to the class.

UNIT 13 – Our School

Phonics final set. Subjects, opinions, rooms, telling time, numbers to 100, Make booklet to show our school.

UNIT 12 – Clothes

Exploring clothes in French with their correct article, how to talk about the colour of an item. Meeting the regular verb to wear and how to use it to say what you and others are wearing. Fashion parade.



UNIT 15 - Eat and Move! + Transition to year 7

Exploring the concept of being healthy in what we eat and do. Revision of grammar and vocab in preparation for secondary.

UNIT 14– The weekend

What we get up to and meeting the verbs that help us say it together with more complex connectives.
