## <u>Key Substantive Concepts (know what)</u>

Symbol	Concept and Definition
	<b>Significant Events</b> The key happenings surrounding the events and the accomplishments that have been made as a result.
	<b>Significant People</b> Who has played an important role within the event or events and changes that have taken place.
**	<b>Civilisation</b> The way of life in particular areas or at a particular period in time.
	<b>Empire</b> An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by one single ruler or state.
	<b>Legacy – Influence and Impact</b> The effect that someone or something has on someone or something else and may still be effective today.
	<b>Invasion</b> An act or instance of invading by an enemy or hostile army.
