Teaching and Learning

Provide high quality training to enhance the delivery and maximise impact of the RWInc Programme. £500

To provide opportunities for staff to develop their skills in identifying, supporting and enhancing provision for children with a variety of learning needs, through ongoing CPD. £400

Purchase high quality age appropriate books for lower ability readers. £300

Targeted Support

Employ a Speech and Language Therapist to ensure early identification of needs and support the delivery of SAL plans. 5000

Support complex needs of pupils through additional adult support. 5,591.67

Pastoral Lead employed to offer support, advice and guidance to disadvantaged, service and young carer families, as well as emotional well being support for pupils. £12,000

The emotional needs and well-being for all pupils are supported through access to a trained ELSA and nurture room. £6000

Maintain subscription to Multi Agency Support Team (MAST) to provide support for targeted pupils and families. £20, 827.50

A dedicated TA to deliver high quality speech and language follow up interventions.
